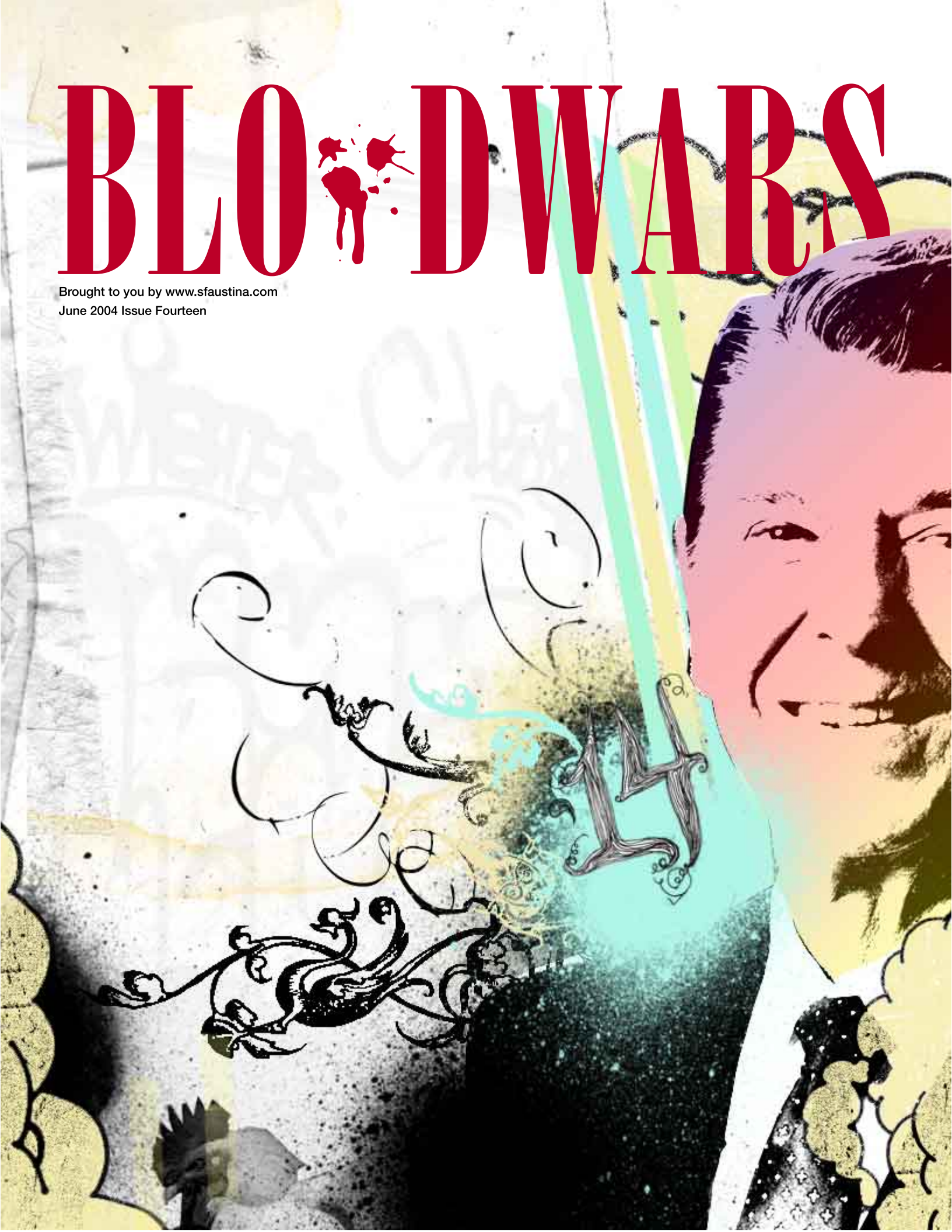

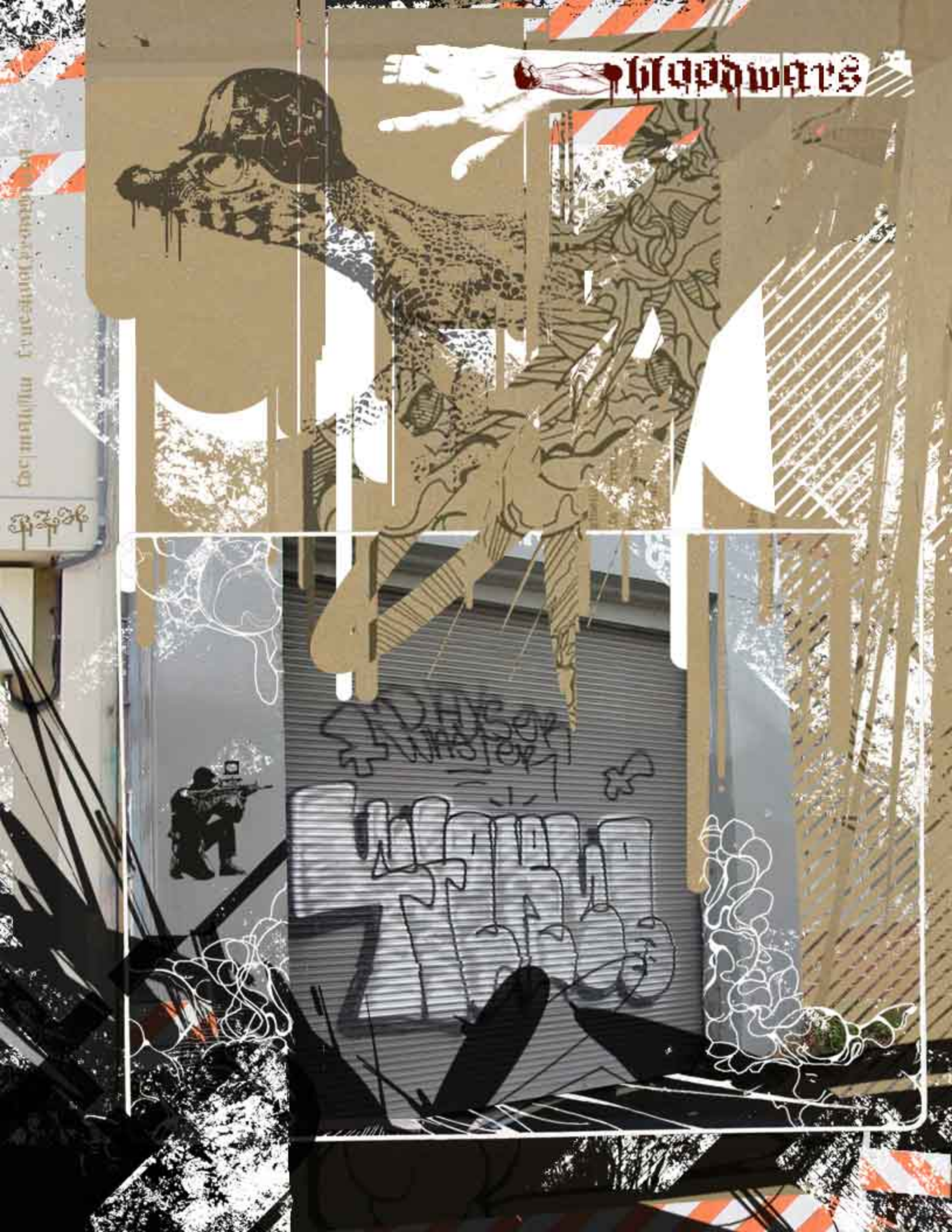
GEOFF Clark has become used to seeing his name in headlines, but the latest public exposure has angered the former ATSIIC boss. A graffiti attack has painted Mr Clark's name in big letters over the front of a controversial heritage building in Warrnambool. The vandalism is the latest in a series of problems to beset the heritage-listed property at 94 Merri Street.

The painted message included Mr Clark's name and the term 'wounded bear' which was used in a Melbourne newspaper as the title of a feature article on the Framlingham-based Aboriginal leader in the form of an email address. It also includes the term 'sacred site'. Mr Clark was unaware of the graffiti attack until told by The Standard late yesterday. "I find it very insulting. I have interest in culture and heritage and I've spent a lot of energy trying to protect heritage," he said. "I get blamed for a lot of things and it isn't good to have your name used this way.

"It's obviously a political opponent, but they seem to know what they're talking about. There's the website (geoffclark.com.au) and the 'wounded bear' comes from the article they did in Melbourne." Mr Clark said the email was not his address. The property which was earmarked for demolition before Heritage Victoria stepped in has previously been vandalised and burnt. It is understood that Heritage Victoria has approved the demolition of a small section at the rear of the building.

But another application for further works has led to Heritage Victoria asking the owner, Terry Board, of Melbourne, to provide a detailed overall plan for the building.

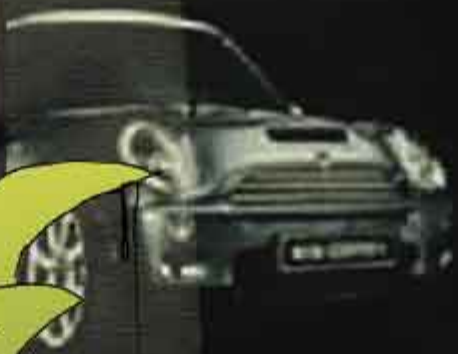
More than 900 people in San Antonio turned out to fight the war against graffiti Saturday, as part of the second annual Graffiti Wipeout Volunteer Day. The event was organized by the San Antonio Graffiti Task Force and close to 100,000 square feet of graffiti in the city was cleared. Graffiti Wipeout Volunteer Day “You know, we all want a nice clean place to live. We want to maintain home and continue those property values of our homes, but everybody wants to live in a beautiful surrounding and wiping out graffiti is one way we can make a difference,” Graffiti Task Force Chairperson Nellie Gomez Shannon said. The second annual Graffiti Wipeout Volunteer Day took place Saturday and about 900 volunteers helped clean-up. However, according to reports, the price of cleaning up graffiti costs American taxpayers \$8 billion each year. For those who are caught illegally spray painting, the fine can be as high as \$10,000 and time in prison depending on the amount of property damage. Locally, the event brought several groups and people together to help clean the area. “Tall guys were helping to get the high spots, the short people and the kids were getting the low spots — working together beautifully. It went a lot faster than I thought it was going to,” Graffiti Wipeout volunteer Don Robinson said. The Graffiti Task Force reminds everyone that winning the war against Graffiti can’t be done in one day and they cleaned up one wall at a time.

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Graffiti Spreading All Over the Valley Tagging, Street graffiti - sign of disrespect

Graffiti is a growing and expensive problem for local neighborhoods. Last year, cleaning up graffiti cost taxpayers more than \$1 million. As the numbers of people in the valley grow, so do the number of walls filled with graffiti. The city of Las Vegas has three full-time employees who remove graffiti by painting over it, or blasting it off with a power sprayer. But many say as soon as the graffiti is removed, it reappears. Whitney Green lives near Bonanza and Sandhill, she watched as a city worker painted over a wall filled with graffiti. She says the graffiti in her area is so bad, she doesn't even notice it anymore. "I give it a day or two and it will be right back up again," Green said. David Semenza works for Neighborhood Response, which is in charge of graffiti removal for the city of Las Vegas. "We keep saying we have more paint than they do, but sometimes I wonder," Semenza said.

Last year, the city of Las Vegas spent \$679,000 dollars cleaning up graffiti. In North Las Vegas, the cost of graffiti removal was \$270,000. Henderson taxpayers footed a \$141,000 dollar bill and Clark County spent a whopping \$450,000 for clean up. The cities and county pays for removal on homes and the fronts of business, but businesses have to pay for removal of graffiti that is in less noticeable areas. If you see someone spray painting, you are asked to take down any identifying information and call the Graffiti hotline in your area. You can also call these numbers to get graffiti removed from your
