Another prevailing aspect of the art commonly forgotten when a shiny side of steel is involved are walls.

In a state where the transport system is small, tight and efficient with opportunities for painting the electrics kept to a strict minimum, a good lay-up consisting of four minutes painting time and a large chance of not finishing at all. The Western Australian public transportation system operated by Transperth under Westrail (soon to be TransWA and government owned) has managed to develop exceptional methods of preventing 'panel assaults' as is evident by the vast number of sensors, cameras and razor wire at the only main yard. Interstaters and other foreigners get a small shock when they discover that less than 50 trains

are kept safe in one and a half yards. Unlike in other cities where enough writers see panels running the lines that everyone pretty much knows what's going down in the steel scene, Perth panels usually run for no more than half a day before going to the buff. However the fact that it is a small scene means that the 'word of mouth' effect is particularly chronic and whether you want it or not everyone gets a fair idea of what's going on. Despite the evident challenges the sense of achievement on completion of a panel is that much more satisfying, and has therefore become an addiction and passion to a handful of dedicated writers.



Finding motivation to rock train line productions is hard when the buff often manages to dispose of the work before the artists get a daytime glimpse. Some of the best pieces to land on Perth soils can be found at the East Perth Hall of Fame which holds a solid production including some TFC gems like the dash below. The difficulties posed by electric trains in WA has meant that freights are a particularly common canvas for artistic expression. The Perth freight scene was very dominant until recently when the workers finally had enough and the huge rust infested beasts became a lot more challenging to paint.

As a number of other WA writers have done, what and skope have moved worldwide representing Perth and FDP on clean cut panels and track-side

productions. Perth peeps always await the next installment from these lads as they cruise through Europe leaving their mark where ever they go. In terms of artistic style, the AM crue continues to hold the wall/production scene on lockdown. It's good to see old-school king, kudos consistently hurting the city streets with fresh handstyles and the use of alternate mediums such as a range of ill stencils. Hurting all mediums is die, who always manages to leave his mark with style regardless of the occasion. Just goes to show how what might appear a small scene from an outside perspective can be loaded with such varying combinations of artistic style and hardcore actions!

them again i started freaking a bit then we started hearing these barking dogs and they seemed like they were close so we took flicks and cruised, happy to be in one piece...


AMSTERDAM
