

### STOCKHOLM SUBWAY STATIONS

Subway stations in Stockholm have been frequently painted since the mid eighties. But it was not until the cold winter of 1988-89 this scene exploded. Crews like AIO, COC, DST, STM and VIM realized the advantage of reaching a big audience and at the same time avoiding the freezing cold (see UP 9).

Eleven years later many writers still choose to hit the subway stations.

But when the writers in the 80's used hours to complete a piece, it's now a matter of minutes. The pieces could last for weeks or months. Today it's a matter of days or hours.

### STREET ART

Why a special section for »street art«? As if the rest of this magazine didn't cover art that belongs to the street?

It's hard to define where something moves from graffiti into the blurry field of street art (or the other way around). Maybe street art is what can't be called graffiti - the later being a very established and defined form of street art.

So; the expression »Street art« means no more than art in urban environments. Style, technique and purpose can't in this genre be generalized more than in the world of »Art«. What sometimes makes the street art different from writing is that the act takes place in more populated environments and has to be made out faster and more sponta-

This can give the discovery of street art a feeling of suprise and amusement that graffiti sometimes lacks.







### Breaking The Wall – Real Art Is Free

Berlin is no longer a divided city. But the wall still has two sides, and in East Side Gallery one can still see the now classic folk art on a one kilometre long piece, by now rather jaded by the freedom haze of the 90's.

The opposite side of that wall is the West Side Gallery, and there graffiti is the major part. Of course, tourists can still buy pieces of Die Mauer, with an authenticity certificate. I was lucky - in the middle of the night I ran into a guy with a hammer and chisel who gave me a few pieces of whose origination I'm certain of. Real art is free.

And the real graffiti is not found on the Wall, but in Berlin's Hall of Fame, that is called Mauerpark and is situated in Kreuzberg. It is made up of a system of partitions and walls around a highly located soccer stadium, where writers continuously arrive and leave. A walkway leads to the top, and families go there to walk the dog or to let the kids go on the swings. A few kids go around writing a self-secure »Toys« on some pieces. But the pieces that really impress me – after I've climbed trees, over walls and fences to get

the appropriate pictures - is a suite done in 1999 with black spray paint on a gold foundation. This is intuitively something new, stylistically. Freeform threedimensional graffiti shapes with trashy characters. On top a few »conventional« pieces that hit home due to the contrast. This is not only the empire of Amok and Odem but also of countless other skilled and innovative writers who have contributed to Berlin's exceptional position in the graffiti world during the last shivering minutes of the millennium. Akim is good, Shark is a dear reunion and Inka is probably the new great canon. Bens Hip Hop Shop is located at the Lagerweg on the West Side, but the environment could be Kreuzberg with its illegal clubs, rough worn down, decorated alleys with bullet holes in the facades, where anything can happen and one feel transported to Manhattans Lower East or some diffuse 60's. Ben is a round, cheerful and nice Muslim guy, who started this, the first hip hop shop, modelling Hex in Melrose Avenue. He lives in the same building, the store being both work and leisure.

And it is full of hip hop fashion, spray cans of all brands, books, magazines, music and videos. At long we discuss the similarities between Arab art and graffiti, and his self produced fanzine that holds a very high quality in both writing and illustrations impresses me.

As we're walking around Mitte I pick up several German graffiti books. The most interesting is Odems autobiography, edited by the journalist Jürgen Deppe: »Odem: On the Run« is published by Schwartzkopf & Schwartzkopf, who have reached number 9 in their series »Graffiti Art«. Edition Aragon have also been diligent publishers.

Everywhere we find graffiti: by the entrance to the area Schöneberg; on a whole house front, from the top to the bottom, at Friedrichsstrasse. Except on the yellow trains, but it's probably there anyway, somewhere

The liberal \*\*economical freedom\*\* in the west was a disappointment for the \*\*Ossis\*\*, the ex East Berliners. Unemployment was the price to pay. But the art is not a disappointment – and art is free.




